Lighting & Special Features (Optional)

- Uplighting for focal areas – from \$250
- Café or string lighting (one area) – from \$300
- Welcome sign or seating chart display styling – from \$175

Important Scope & Design Limitations

Typical Investment Range

Peak Season Pricing

Peak Season Dates:

February – May | October – November

During peak wedding season, the following minimums apply:

- **Build-Your-Own Base Investment:** *starting at \$1,800*
- **Recommended Minimum Investment:** *\$3,000+*
- Weekend dates are limited and subject to availability
- Priority is given to full décor builds and higher-tier selections

Most couples booking during peak season invest between \$3,500–\$5,500 for complete ceremony and reception décor.

Off-Season Pricing

Off-Season Dates:

June – September

To accommodate slower months, Simply Chic Weddings may offer flexible investment options based on availability.

- **Build-Your-Own Base Investment:** *starting at \$1,500*
- Reduced minimums may be available for select dates
- Limited décor scope may apply (smaller guest counts or reduced installations)
- Off-season incentives may include bonus décor elements or package enhancements
